The ENDURANCE project is a 3-year Horizon Europe initiative funded under Grant Agreement no. 101168007 aimed at strengthening the resilience of Europe's Critical Infrastructures (CI), which includes sectors such as energy, health, digital services, public administration, drinking water and wastewater.

1. Working Group Meetings: Advancing Europe's Resilience Agenda

On 19 June and 14 October 2025, ENDURANCE hosted the 2nd and 3rd Pan-European Working Group Meetings on Disruption Resilience. The June meeting was co-organised with the [SUNRISE Project](#)'s Working Group on Resilience to Pandemics, reinforcing cross-project collaboration in CI security



Experts from across Europe explored strategies for:

- Digital and cross-sector resilience
- Legal and ethical challenges and gaps in building CI resilience
- Technology integration and Digital Twin adoption
- Functional overview of the ENDURANCE Architecture
- The upcoming European Disruption Resilience Strategy developed by the project

The 14 October session marked an important milestone, one year into the project, providing an opportunity to review achievements, discuss learnings from the first year of execution, and validate the strategic and technical directions that will shape the second phase of ENDURANCE.

Partners also reflected on key enablers for integrating resilience solutions into operational environments across Europe.

Through this collaborative exchange, participants contributed valuable perspectives on how to bridge current gaps and strengthen the practical implementation of resilience frameworks across sectors.

Looking ahead, the insights and recommendations gathered during both meetings will support the ongoing refinement of ENDURANCE's methodologies and tools, fostering alignment with broader EU resilience and innovation objectives.
